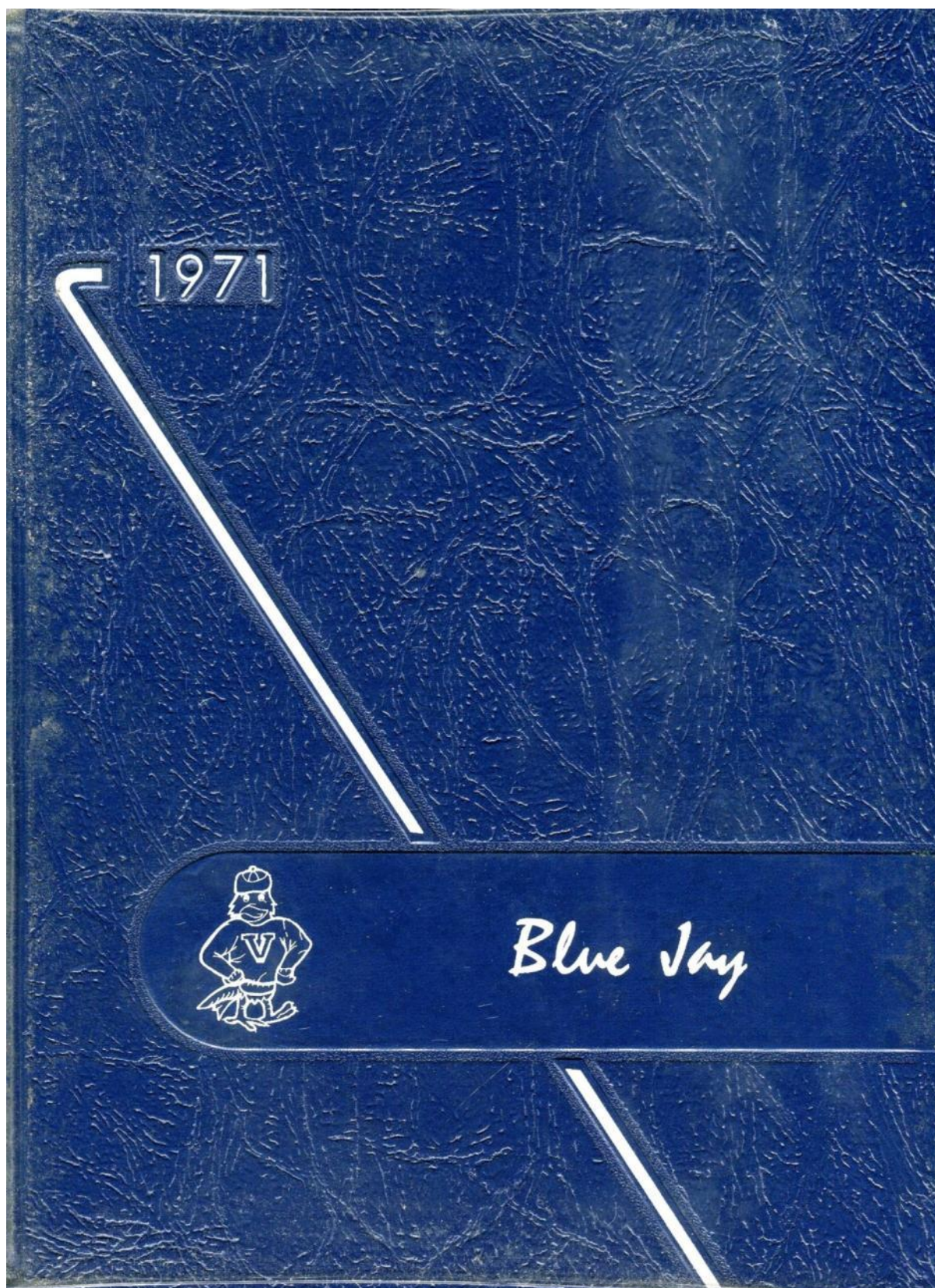

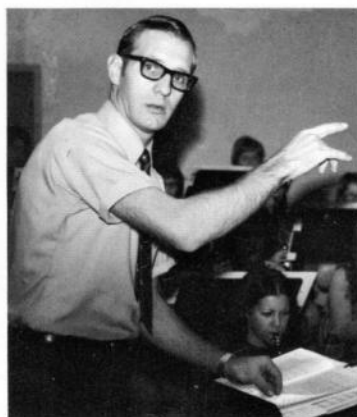
Foreword
