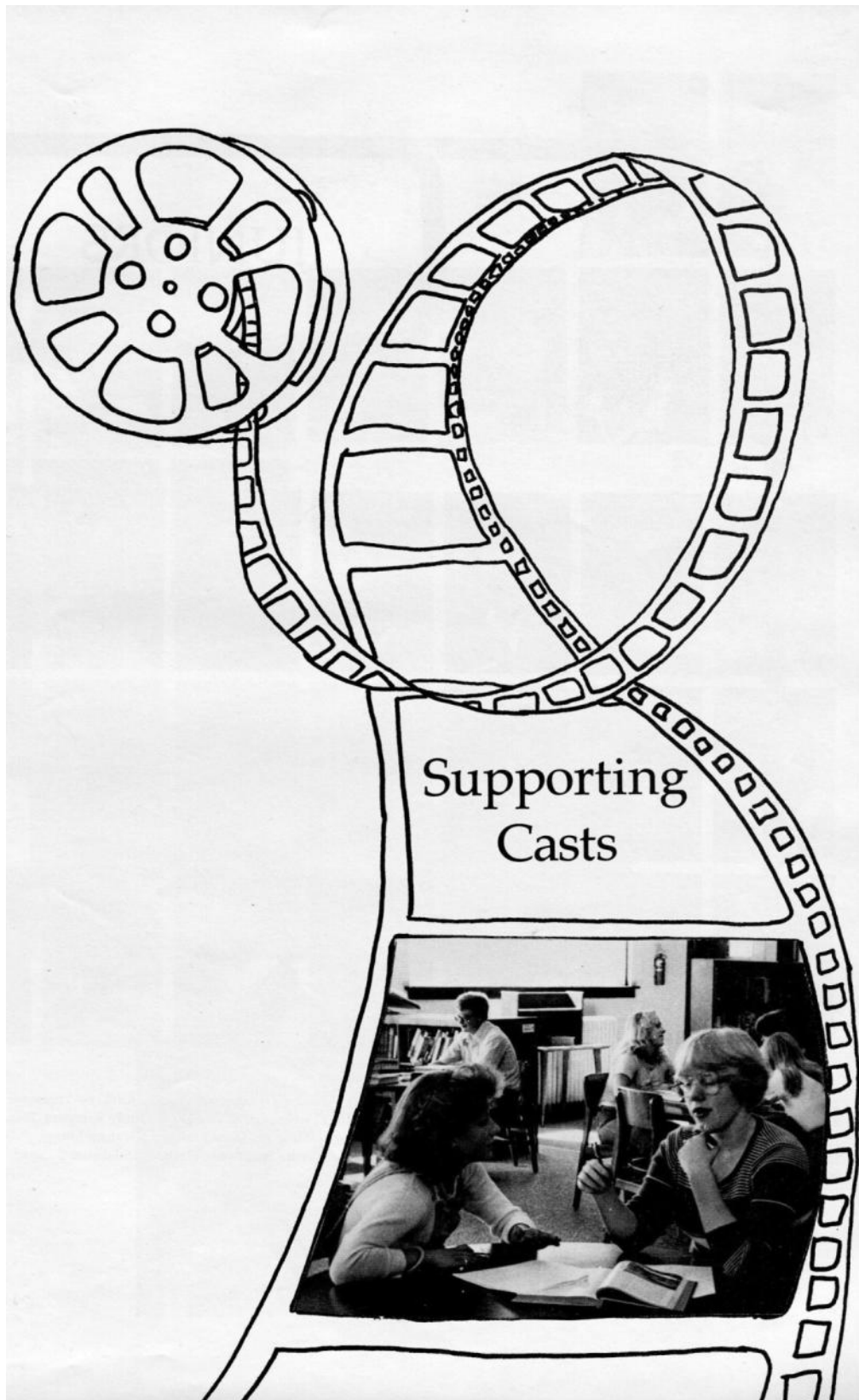


In Memory

We will remember Debbie each in our own way, and these memories will linger forever. Her quiet and thoughtful manner gained the respect of many friends.





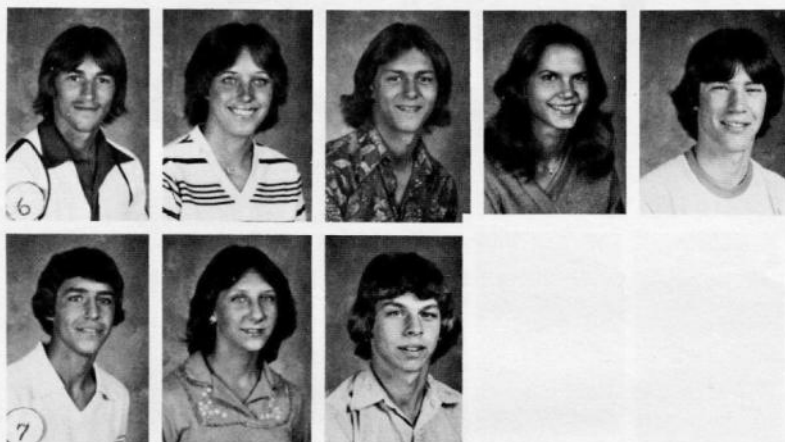

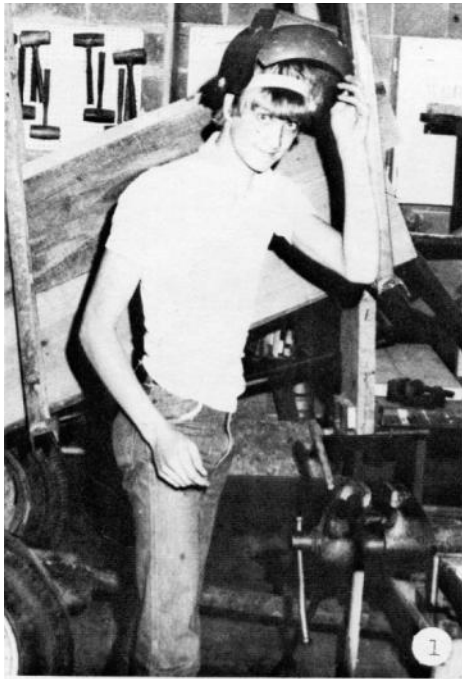
