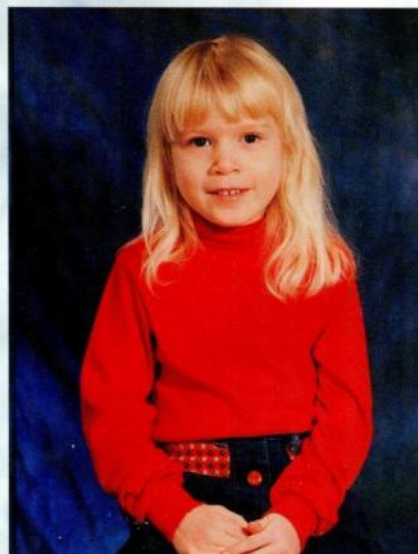
Holly attended preschool in Villisca and Corning, and elementary school in Creston.

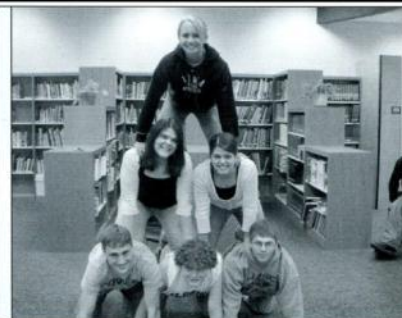

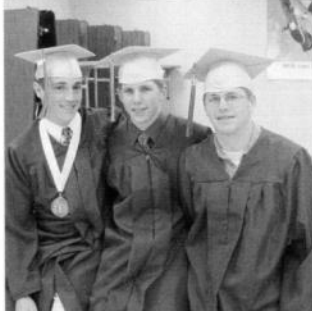

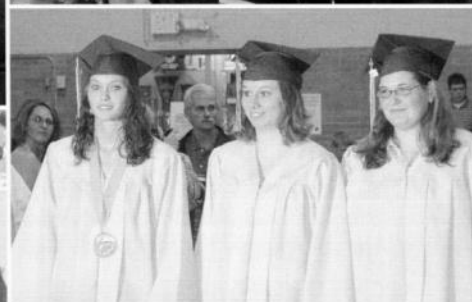

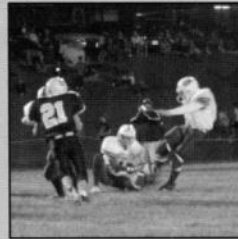

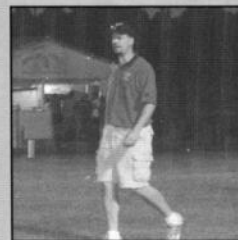

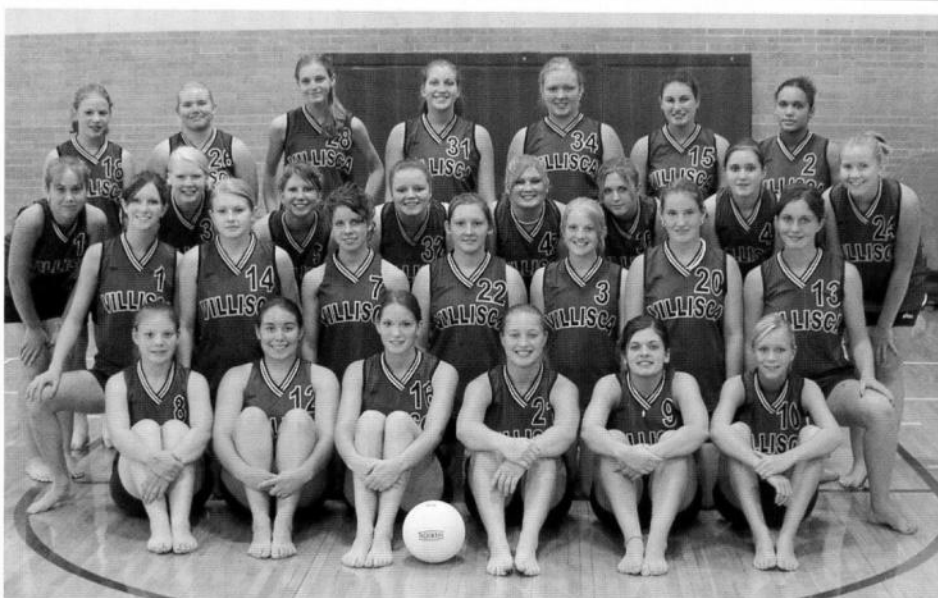

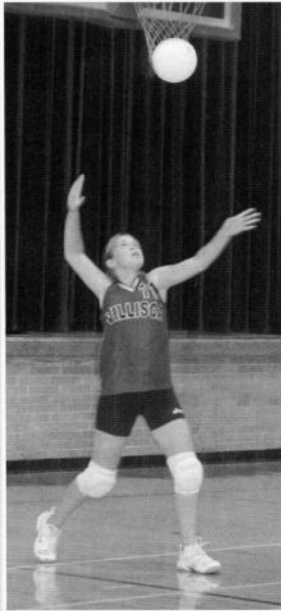

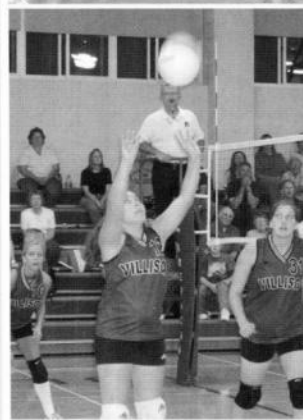

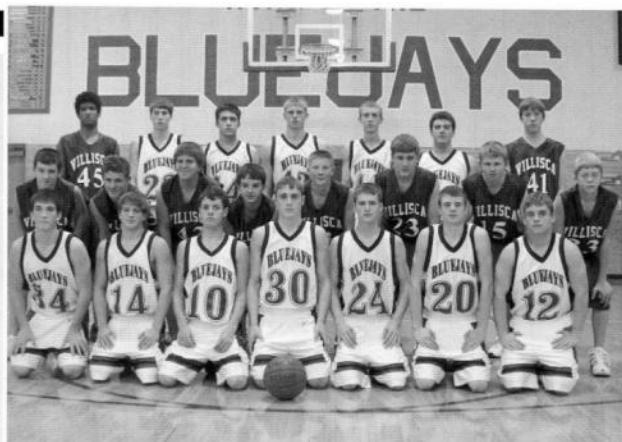

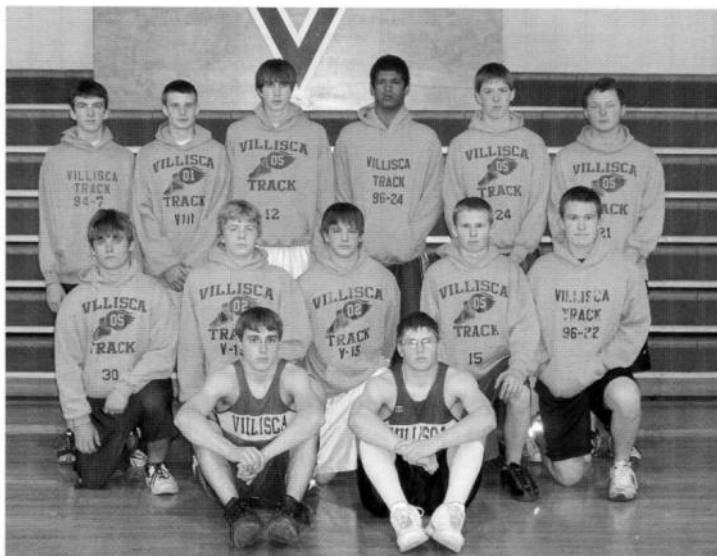

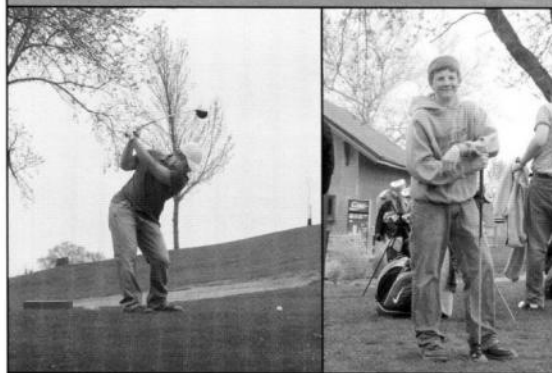

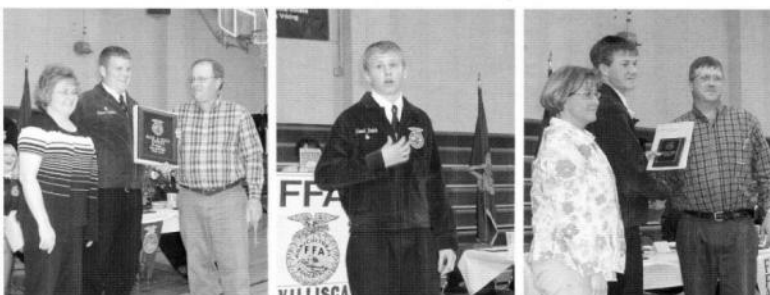

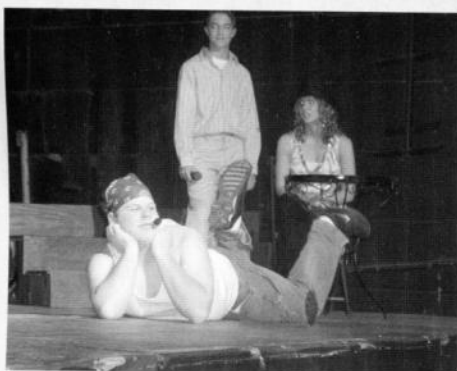

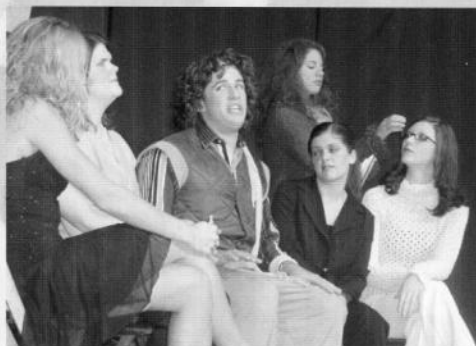
